This may be done using one of our trusted inspection partners, or we may offer you the opportunity to complete your own self-guided inspection using Flyreel's Al-powered app on your personal smart device. The Philadelphia Contributionship has been working with Flyreel since 2021 to provide our customers with an easy, quick, convenient and secure way to provide important information about their property without scheduling an in-person inspection. Both paths will ensure you have the proper coverage and are well protected in case of an unexpected loss, but the self-guided inspection allows you to perform this at your own pace. Our underwriters will review this inspection, policy declarations and other documentation to verify policy details and evaluate your property for any existing risks, dangers or damages and may reach out to your agent to discuss your coverage. Your agent may also contact you as a part of this process. The vast majority of our policyholders will not need to be contacted about anything, but in the event that there is a hazard that must be remediated, a reasonable timeframe is provided to address necessary repairs.

You will receive renewal documents prior to the anniversary of your effective date. In the event that your situation may have changed, due to renovations, additions or other life events please reach out to your insurance agent to ensure your information is current and your coverage fits your needs.
